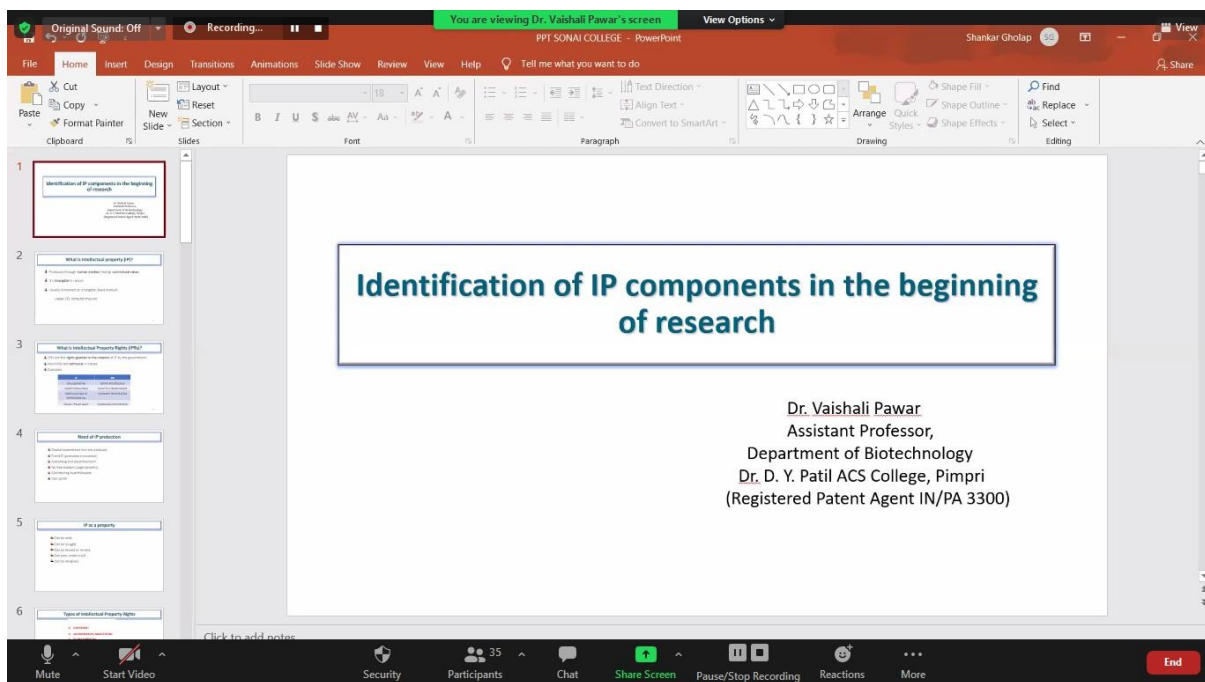
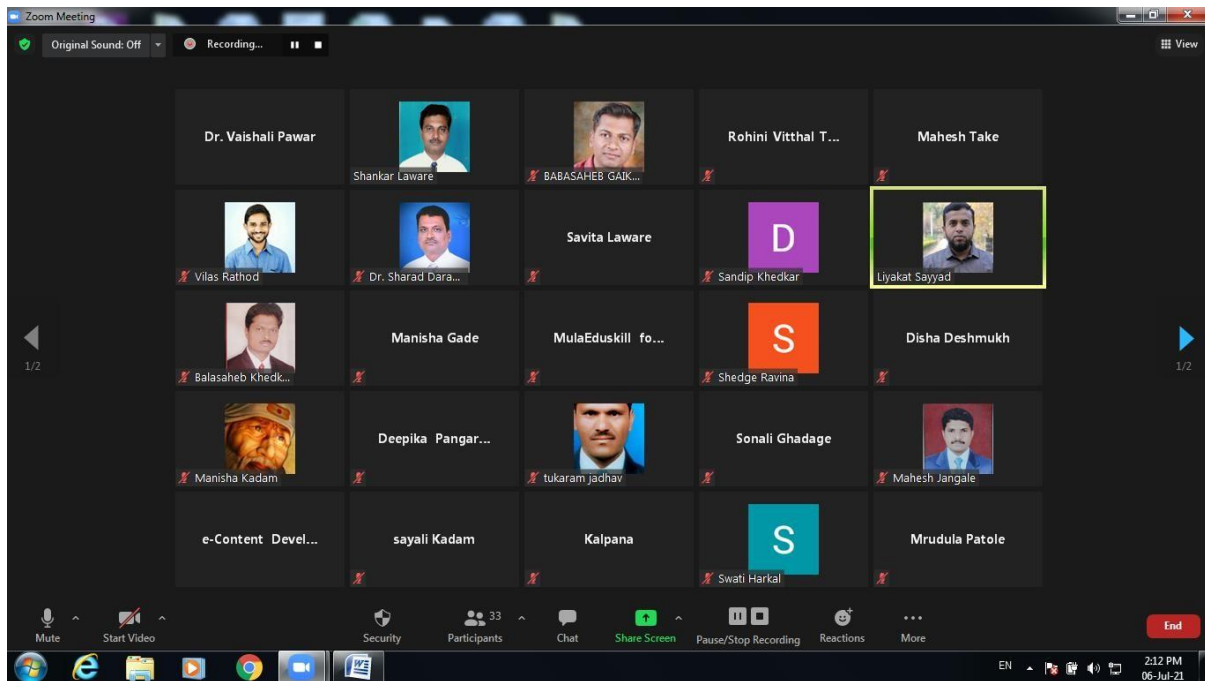

A webinar on the topic "Research & Innovation Ethical Issues" under IIC of the college was organized on 28 June 2021 for the faculty and the students. Dr. Parul Sharma Saluja, Dept of Biological Sciences, School of Natural Science, University of Zambia, South Central Africa, graced this occasion as the keynote speaker.

In her lecture, she focused on the subject of research, research misconduct, types of plagiarism, plagiarism detection & its tools, research ethics and „Turnitin“. Initially, she explained the concept of research with the example of current pandemic corona. According to her, research is nothing but understanding problem, think on how to solve it, make the observation & study on it. She explained the process of research and its stages, like define the problem, review the literature, research design, formulate hypothesis, carry out the research, interpret, result and report.

In the second topic Research misconduct, she explained three types of misconduct- fabrication, falsification and plagiarisms. Plagiarism can appear in a research article or program in many ways, like textual plagiarism and source code plagiarism. After giving very detailed information about plagiarisms, she discussed on plagiarism detection tools, its functions and its types based on whether it is paid or free, like Copycatch, Eve2, GPSP, Code Match, Safe Assingment, Urkund, Wcopyfind, DocCop, Mass, Jplag, SID and SIM etc. She also narrated widely used plagiarism detection tools like monolingual plagiarism detection and crosslingual plagiarism detection.

Dr. Parul also discussed on research ethics which provide guidelines for the responsible conduct of research. She listed principles of research ethics like honesty, objectivity, integrity, carefulness, confidentiality and legality etc. At the end of session she explained term „Turnitin“, which is an American internet based plagiarism detection service run by the US Company Turnitin.

Mr. Mahesh Bahirat coordinated the webinar. Principal Dr. Shankar Laware guided for the smooth organization of the activity. Prof. Liyakat Sayaid proposed the vote of thanks. & Dr. Shweta Choudhary prepared the report of the program.

Total 75 participants participated in the webinar

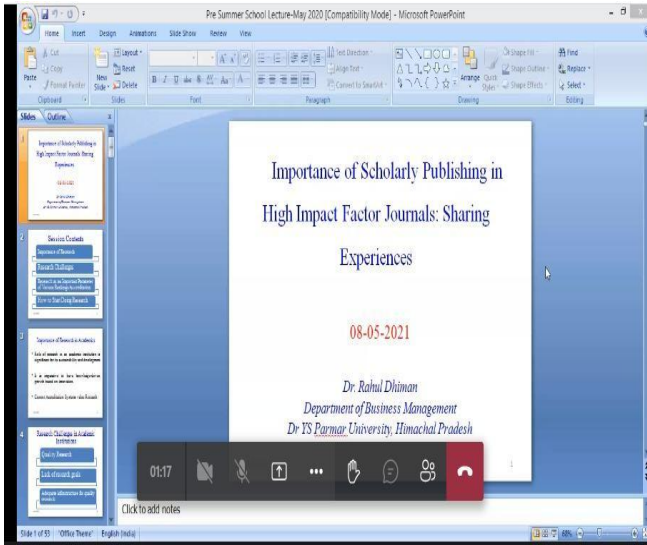

We had **33** participants from all over India, **4** of them from Kerala, **2** of them from Andhra Pradesh and rest of them from Maharashtra. **2** of them from Sant **Gadgebaba** Amravati University, Amravati, **3** from **Kaviyatri Bahinabai Choudhari North Maharashtra University Jalgaon**, **1** from **Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University Nanded**, **10** from **Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad** and **11** from **Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune**.

The Resource Persons also called here from all over India, **6** from **outside** Maharashtra (Chennai, Delhi, Kolkata, Aligarh, Amarkantak and Delhi) and rest from **different** parts of Maharashtra.

The aim of the Short Term Course was almost achieved as the Resource Persons focused on how to teach particular topic to the Students. I hope these teachers will **inculcate** the teaching pedagogies to their students. Thus new tools and knowledge will be **imparted** to students from different parts of India through the participant teachers. The details regarding **focus** on how to teach is as follows:



1. Dr. Umesh Bagade in his keynote address discussed about various trends in Indian Historiography and focused on how to teach to the students. He also focused on two way interaction between teacher and the students so as to understand the needs, knowledge of the students. He stressed the need to make students alert and prepare them to grasp various concepts deeply.
2. Dr. V Geetha gave an excellent lecture on Feminist Historiography and also focused on how to teach students. She asked participants to make a group discussion on feminist questions. Teacher should finally give his/her opinion on the topic.
3. Dr. Radhika Seshan delivered studious lectures on Medieval historiography and Maritime historiography, in which she focused on questioning the students about the topic so that we should know how much they are understanding.
4. Dr. Prakash Shirsat discussed the important aspect of nationalism and historiography. He also told to include students in the teaching learning process by two way interaction between students and teacher.
5. Dr. Shruti Tambe delivered an excellent lecture on Interdisciplinary approach to Social History, in which she made a group discussion of the participants and showed how students should be involved in the teaching learning process.
6. Dr. Arun Bandopadhyaya delivered two lectures on Socio-Cultural Historiography in India: Some Methodological and Substantial Issues. He also focused on using new technology such as ICT to make the students understand the topic.
7. Dr. Raja Dixit also focused on interdisciplinary approach to Indian historiography and added new techniques of teaching such as discussing with students on the topic, asking them to present their views and finally giving them proper idea of the topic.
8. Dr. Lahu Gaikwad also told how to teach local historiography to the students with taking them out to historical places in the villages.
9. Dr. Anirudh Deshpande delivered two lectures on Making of Modern Historiography and Indian Cinema and History. He also focused on the new way of teaching students through the use of modern technology. He told that the student should get the idea of the topic by watching movies and reading reference books and then there should be a discussion on it in the classroom.
10. Dr. Ishrat Alam delivered two lectures on Technology and Society in Pre-Modern India and focused on use of PPTs to make the topic easy for students. His presentation was very easy to understand due to use of modern technology.
11. Dr. Kishor Gaikwad delivered amazing lectures on Post-Marxism tools of Analysis in History, Interdisciplinary Approach to Ancient Indian History and Micro-history: Interdisciplinary to Cross-disciplinary Approach. He focused on how to use Post Marxist tools for analysis of Indian History. He also taught us how to teach Ancient Indian History with interdisciplinary approach with his ppt presentation. He also taught how the research should be done at micro level with citing an example of Dalit Culture in Mumbai. He used govt. data to do his research.

12. Dr. Rambhau **Mutkule** delivered studious lecture on Maratha **Historiography**: Some Substantial Issues, in which he focused on Chhatrapati Sambhaji's **history**. He focused on how to rewrite history by using interdisciplinary tools.
13. Prof. Devendra **Ingle** delivered two lectures on In Search of New **Theories** to interrogating Indian History – **Genocide Theory** and **Critical Race Theory**. He also **told** how to use new theories to rewrite **Indian Historiography** by using **Interdisciplinary approach**. With the help of **Power Point Presentation** how we can make the students prepare for understanding a particular topic.
14. Dr. Chandrakant **Bawiskar** delivered excellent lecture on **Education and Writing** of History in which he also focused on new tools to teach students effectively.
15. Dr. Nirmal Kumar delivered two excellent lectures on **Cultural Historiography** and **Medieval Historiography**, in which he also focused on the use of **ICT** and **participation** of students in the teaching learning process.
16. Dr. Dilip Chavan delivered excellent lectures on **Post-Colonial Historiography** and **Gender Studies** where he **taught us** how to involve students in the process of **teaching** learning with the help of **ppts** and **questioning** the students on the topic. He focused on **how to learn** and do research on **Feminist History**.

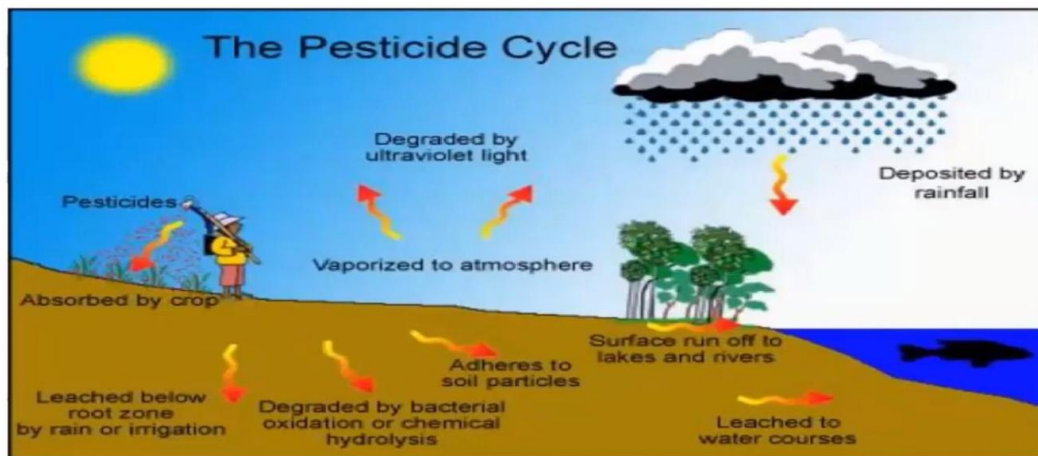

### Rampant use of pesticides hits bird population

Trichy: Birds such as cattle egrets, lapwings and pond herons, once common in paddy fields during ploughing, have become a rarity nowadays. Indiscriminate use of pesticides and chemical fertilizers in the agrarian lands of Trichy and Perambalur districts is affecting the avian diversity, a study conducted by an ecologist finds. The farming community in many rural pockets has been using pesticides without knowing that it would affect a range of organisms that are essential for our ecology. These pesticides are not only killing or driving away birds, but also make micro-changes in the environment that would lead to climate change, said environment and wildlife biologist O Ashoka Chakkaravarthy, who has conducted a study in Thuraiyur, Kannappadi village - located near the foothills of Pachaimalai, Nagalapuram, Thanjavur and Annamalaiyem in the two districts. "Farmers use various kinds of pesticides for weeding. They use insecticides to kill insects, herbicides to destroy weed plants and rodenticides to kill rats and mice. They use these pesticides without knowing that they have severe effects on a range of organisms that provide ecological services like pollination (honey bees, butterflies and moths) and natural pest controllers such as snakes, frogs, owls and seed dispersing birds," Chakkaravarthy said.

**Overall report of the Activity:**

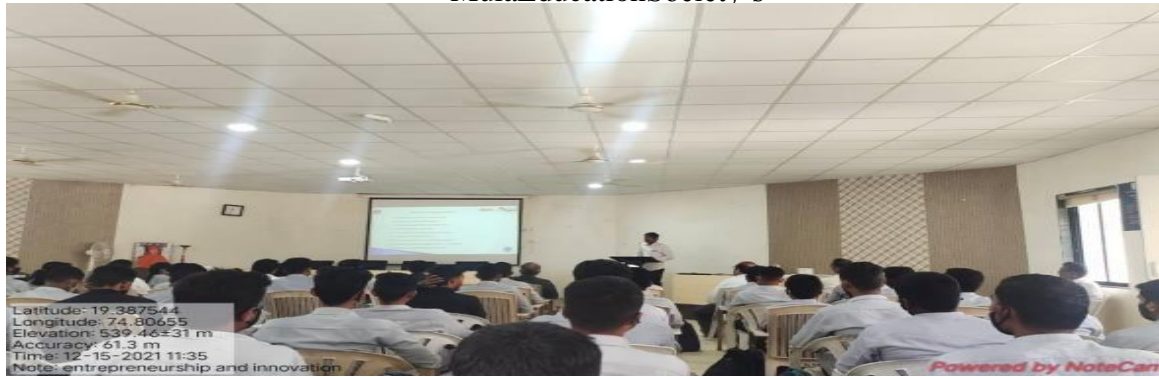
