Report on 'A Week Celebration of NEP 2020'

Aims & Objectives

- 1) To help students to understand 'National Education Policy 2020'
- 2) To explain how new policy is holistic & flexible learning
- 3) To emphasize on skill based learning experiences
- 4) To inculcate skills such as analytical and critical thinking, experiential learning, and creativity.

Keeping in view probable changes and challenges as the result of globalization, the Government of India felt immense need to transform the traditional setup of education. The government of India in the month of July 2020 accepted the National Education Policy (NEP-2020) which intended at universalization of education from preprimary to higher level. The policy aims to replace current 10+2+3 system with 5+3+3+4 curricular structure corresponding to ages 3-8, 8-11, 11-14 & 14-18. The policy is relevant as it ensures smooth functioning and bridges the gap of communication solidifying as one nation one education policy. To ensure the successful delivery of the content, following activities were planned from 24/7/2023 to 28/7/2023 on the college campus.

1. Lectures: A session was organized for all the students of the college on 24th and 25th July 2023 from 08:00 am to 09:45 am. All the subject teachers lectured on National Education Policy to the students in their respective classes during the above time. The session was organized to inform the students about the National Education Policy and clear their doubts. Dr. Jagdish Sonawane and Prof. Rahul Nipunge worked to organize these lectures.

2. Interview of expert: To ensure proposed delivery of the content to the mass level, an interview with Dr. Kalhapure G.B., Principal, Shri Dnyaneshwar College, Newasa was organized at E- Content Studio of the college which was transmitted online on 25th July 2023 at 10.00 a.m. As an expertise on the area, he answered the questions of immense concerns of various stockholders Students, Parents, Teachers, Management and cross section of Society. He guided the audience in details on fees, Scholarship, Financial Assistance scheme for students, extra-curriculum, Skills Enhancement projects teaching and learning process, student evaluation multi – disciplinary education, syllabi structure student educational facilities, employment, opportunities in business online digital education, collaboration with training, business inter-ship

placement & discussed advantages and disadvantages of the policy. Dr. Sambhaji Darade conducted the interview on the topic & discussed core aspects of the NEP- 2020. 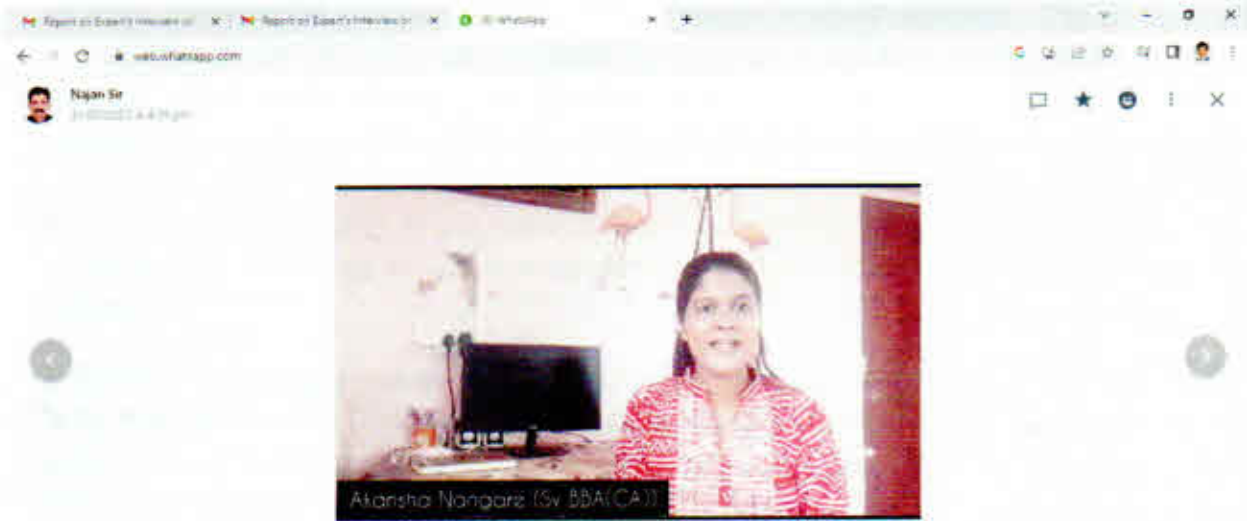
