Overall report of the Activity:

The field visit for problem identification was organized on 28th February 2023 under Institution's Innovation Council of Arts, Commerce and Science College, Sonai.

Total 25 students & 8 faculty were present. Mr. V. P. Rathod delivered introductory speech for the visit; Prof. Dr. M. G. Varpe explained the purpose of visit.

Mr. Sitaram Tuwar informed and guided about the students about the mechanism and management of vegetable oil poured on the idol of Lord Shaneshwar. During the visit he showed underground pipeline through which oil flowed to the collection unit with the capacity of 30 thousand liters. Every day about 3000 to 5000 liter oil has been collected through the pipeline and stored and then oil was further recycled for the lubrication and manufacturing soap. Also it has been transported to various cosmetic and automobile industries. In the visit, he also focused on problem identification and recycling of the waste into wealth. Vote of thank was delivered by Ms. A. S. Sayyed

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
