Savitribai Phule: Pioneer of Gender Equality

Arts, Commerce and Science College, Sonai organized a lecture on “Savitribai Phule: Pioneer of Gender Equality” on the occasion of Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule Memorial Day in collaboration with IQAC, Department of History, Committee against sexual harassment and *Pragatishasit Itihas Sanstha*, Aurangabad. As a chief guest for this event professor Dr. Dinkar Murkute, Mahatma Phule College, Pimpri, Dr. Lahu Gaikwad, Narayangeon College, Pune, and Smt. Varsha Bade, Secretary, Satyashodhak Mahila Aghadi, Pune were present. on this occasion the Joint Secretary of the Mula Education Society Dr. Vinayak Deshmukh, Principle of the college Dr. Lawre, Vice Principal Dr. Zine were present.

While delivering the keynote address, Dr. Lahu Gaikwad explained how to achieve our aim. According to him, instead of urging others if, we change our self, than there is no need for celebrating Woman’s Day. History inspires a change of the mindset this motivation leads to thoughtful action that is why thoughts of served by fully is inspiring for us Swami Vivekananda went beyond the concept of men-women and they introduce them as a relationship on the basis of emotion. On the other hand Savitribai Phule introduces his relationship in terms of equality. Savitribai’s thoughts and vision were clear about who to work for and what purpose that clarity is needed today. Dr. Gaikwad said when we shall understand the difference between freedom and uncontrolled freedom, than we shall no more used the concepts of men-women freedom. Savitribai flourished Mahatma Phule’s ideological world. However, when talking about woman emancipation or gender equality we should remember Savitribai’s thoughts as well as Mukta Salve, Tarabai Shinde and Fatima Sheikh thoughts and also think where they have gone. The first British education did not mention girls’ education. About girl’s education, medieval feudal thoughts slept the society by Savitribai and encouraged girls to take education. By reading

Savitribai's Literature we know she was the best Sanskrit scholar, translator. According to Dr. Gaikwad she's a poet who is representing modern age. In his speech Dr. Gaikwad reviewed modern farming through Satya Shodhank Samaj and views of Savitribai an astrology.

Dr. Dinker Murkute reviewed MukundRao Patil and his work for gender equality. He analyzed Mukundrao Patil & his Satya Shodhak thoughts. Mukundrao Patil wrote many articles in 'Dinmitra' and 'Dinbandhu' newspaper. He had an ideological confrontation with the orthodox people. He used his writing for the Bahujan samaj and women's upliftment. Due to his actions like 'Kulkarnililamrut' British government took back kulkarni's inheritance and appointed officer instead Mukundrao Patil who was a pioneer in the Non-Brahahmin movement, was emotional but decided no compromise with the rules. He classified his views on World War II, while on the other hand insisted on providing modern machinery and loans for upliftment of poor. He insisted on availing loans to farmers. He wrote a book '*Chankdraloki chi Vilaskshan Rudhi*' for problems of women.

Smt. Varsha Bade while interacting with the student's highlighted the gender in equality that is inadvertaulty inculcated in films and daily series. She said that the dowry creates tension in the minds of parents and was fatal to the society. He explained the belief that effective implementation of inheritance rights and share in wealth would help women to stand on their own feet. Gender in the society is intentional and the patriarchal mentality refuses to accept equality.

Dr. Shweta Choudhare president of the Committee against Sexual Harassment introduced the program, Dr. Sambhai Darade, HoD Dept of History and Dr. Jagdish Sonawane, IQAC Coordinator and Secretary *Pragetihasic Itihas Sanstha*, Aurangabad welcomes the guests. Miss. Ravina Shedge anchor the program.
