



World No Tobacco Day

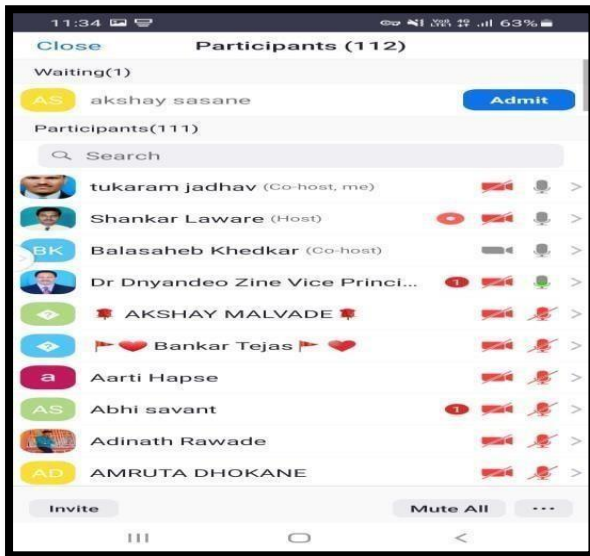
