born equal and everyone has a freedom to live their life in their own way. Babasaheb had devoted his life to remove untouchability. He believed that the progress of the Nations the caste system in totality.

Dr. Ambedkar analyses Hindu society before starting his struggle against untouchability and the cast system. He was scholar as much as a man of action in any case before becoming one. In his writing Ambedkar tried hard to show the mechanism of the caste system and clarified the origin of untouchability in order to support his file for equality. Casteism is a stain Indian culture he had said that this is a system that restricts the freedom of man and it should be removed (Ambedkar Mahesh-2016).

Ambedkar concept of social justice stands for the Liberty, equality and fraternity of all human beings. He is stored for a social system that is a based on right relation between man and women in all spheres on his life.
